Useful Information When Boarding

Arrival/Departure Times:

It is best if cats are brought here and collected in mornings (10.30-11am). If it is not possible to do so in the morning then it may be arranged between 5.30 and 6pm. Arrival and Departure times must be arranged in advance.

The Journey

Please do not feed your cat immediately prior to travelling, as some cats suffer from travel sickness. However, experience has taught us that it is best to feed him/her a small meal about two hours before coming to Cuddles. Be sure to line your cat carrier with newspaper for the journey, just in case. Being fed shortly after arrival will help your cat to relax and get his or her holiday off to a good start!

A note about completing the booking form

It is important that you are specific about the food on the booking form. Please state the brand; whether your cat normally eats tins or pouches; whether adult or kitten variety and in gravy or jelly and also let me know his or her favourite flavours. Please also specify preferred types of dry food. Your cat will thank you for your attention to this.

What to Bring:

Please remember to bring the following when boarding your cat(s):

1. Vaccination Record Card. For the health and safety of all cats in the cattery, no cat can be admitted without full, current vaccinations. Please also see terms and conditions on booking form.
2. A bed or blanket that your cat normally uses (unwashed). If your cat sleeps in a human's bed, put a towel or blanket or rug underneath him or her for a few nights before boarding and bring that. Note: DO NOT put your cat's bed in his/her carrier as it may get soiled en route.
3. Any special food that you would like given to your cat during his/her stay.
4. Some favourite toys.
5. A scratching post (if your cat has one) or a favourite scratching mat.
6. A brush or comb if your cat has one. Remember to let us know if your cat does not like being brushed in a certain area!
